

Instruction for Final Exam

Dates of the exam: June 8-9, 2026

The final exam consists of **5 main sections**. Please read the instructions for each section carefully.

Section 1: Reading (30 pts.)

You will read an essay. The essay will include some comprehension questions (10 pts.)

Sub-Section: Vocabulary – Essay will include vocabulary questions (10 pts.)

Sub-Section: Grammar – Essay will include grammar questions (10 pts.)

Section 2: Functional Language (15 points)

You will read example situations and write appropriate responses for each.

Section 3: Listening (15 pts.)

You will listen to an audio file and answer the questions based on this audio. (10 pts.)

Sub-Section: Vocabulary – Audio file will include vocabulary questions (5 pts.)

Section 4: Writing (20 points)

You will choose **one of the four given topics** and write a **four-paragraph essay** based on it.

Your essay will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Content & Relevance (5 pts)
- Organization (5 pts)
- Grammar & Sentence Structure (4 pts)
- Vocabulary Use (4 pts)
- Linking Words (2 pts)

Section 5: Speaking (20 pts.)

The Speaking section of the final exam consists of **one paired discussion part**.

This part will be based on different discussion tasks covered throughout the year in Main Course and Contemporary Topics.

The speaking exam will be assessed using a detailed rubric focusing on **fluency, vocabulary, grammar, pronunciation, and interaction**.
